Kindergarten Supply List for 2017/18

These items do not need to be labeled

- 1 red plastic 2-pocket folder
- 1 yellow plastic 2-pocket folder
- 1 blue plastic 2-pocket folder
- 1 green plastic 2-pocket folder (*All folders need to be free of any graphics, pictures or writing.*)
- 3 canisters of bleach-free surface wipes (**NO baby wipes**)
- 2 bottles of hand sanitizer (8 oz)
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 tissue box
- 1 pack of Expo, **thin tip**, black dry erase markers (12 count)
- 1 pack of Elmer's glue sticks (2-6 count)
- 1 pack of No. 2 pencils (sharpened)
- 2 large **pink** erasers
- 1 box 24 Count of Crayola colored pencils (24 count)
- 1 pack Crayola markers (24 count)
- 1 pack of white Cardstock Paper (Neenah Bright White 75 sheets or Neenah Exact Index Card 250 sheets)
- 1 pair of children's scissors, rounded tip
 - (**For student's last name beginning A-E: Yellow Handles; F-J: Green handles, K-O: Blue Handles, M-Q: Red Handles, R-Z: Purple Handles**)
- 1 pack of sheet protectors
- 1 package 5 dry-erase pockets (<http://tiny.cc/0sxtjy>) or ([C-line dry reusable pocket](#))
- 1 Scotch Removable Mounting Putty (2-oz)

These items should be labeled with your child's name:

- 1 backpack
- 1 pair of rain boots
- 1 raincoat
- 1 water Bottle - leak-proof metal or plastic with a straw/nozzle (ie Camelbak Eddy, Crocodile Creek)
- 1 change of clothes respecting Le Monde uniform policy.
- 1 emergency kit (see next page)

Your child's backpack, coat, boots, and water bottle can be in any color, design, or pattern and should be labeled with your child's name.

Finally, if your child doesn't know how to tie his/her shoes yet, please opt for no tie shoes or equip their shoes with lock lace elastic shoelaces. Thank you for your understanding.

Emergency Supply Kit

In order to be prepared for emergencies, we request that you send an **Emergency Supply Kit** to school for each child.

These supply kits are kept in the classrooms, so storage space is limited.

- 1) All supplies need to fit in a one-gallon, zip-lock plastic bag. (**No additional supplies can be accommodated.**)
- 2) On the front of the bag write your child's name, the date the supplies were assembled and any emergency telephone numbers or plans that you have for your family. **PLEASE USE A PERMANENT MARKER.**
- 3) **Supply List:**
 - A note from you telling your child that he/she has your permission to stay at school until transportation home has been arranged. This is for your child's reassurance.
 - One space blanket (available at Fred Meyer, Target, etc.)
 - One small flashlight with batteries
 - Two small boxed drinks
 - One can of food with pull-top lid (protein item ideal)
 - One can of dessert with pull-top lid: Fruit, salad, pudding, etc.
 - These have to have a pull-top lid; there will be no openers available.
 - Disposable spoon
 - One small, soft pack of tissues
 - 2 hard candy pieces
 - One poncho, small, purse-size (available at Target, etc.)

Please avoid salty snack foods that will increase thirst.

If your child has any particular medical needs, please consider ensuring that our office has a 24-48 hour supply of medication available at all times.

The kits will be sent home at the end of the school year. Please replenish with fresh supplies and return at the beginning of the next school year. Thank you for working together with us to help keep our kids safe!
