Grade 1 Supply List for 2023/2024

Do not label these items

- 2 boxes of broad-tip Crayola color markers (8- 12 count each)
- 3 boxes of Crayola colored pencils (24 count each)
- 2 boxes of **pre-sharpened** (Ticonderoga if possible) pencils (12 count each)
- 2 boxes Expo **black fine-tip** dry erase markers (12 count each)
- 4 pink erasers
- 15 small Elmer's glue sticks (no oversize glue sticks please)
- 3 boxes of Kleenex tissues
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 4 containers of Lysol or Lysol-type disinfecting wipes
- 2 bottles of hand sanitizer (must be at least 60% alcohol)
- 3 Mead Primary K-2 Journals (lined paper with blank space for a drawing at the top of each page)

Label these items with your child's name

- 1 backpack
- 1 pencil pouch or pencil box
- 1 blue plastic folder
- 1 red plastic folder
- 1 green plastic folder
- 3 Dry Erase Pockets 9x12 inches (such as C-Line, Clipco, etc.)
- 1 water bottle with straw or spout
- 1 emergency supply kit (see next page)
- 1 ThinkWrite or similar headset with microphone

Emergency Supply Kit

In order to be prepared for emergencies, we request that you send an Emergency Supply Kit to school for each child.

These supply kits are kept in the classrooms, so storage space is limited.

1) All supplies need to fit in a one-gallon, zip-lock plastic bag. (No additional supplies can be accommodated.)

2) On the front of the bag write your child's name, the date the supplies were assembled and any emergency telephone numbers or plans that you have for your family. PLEASE USE A PERMANENT MARKER.

3) Supply List:
