Emergency Supply Kit

In order to be prepared for emergencies, we request that you send an Emergency Supply Kit to school for each child.

- 2) On the front of the bag write your child's name, the date the supplies were assembled and any emergency telephone numbers or plans that you have for your family. PLEASE USE A PERMANENT MARKER.

☐ One can of dessert with pull-top lid: Fruit, salad, pudding, etc.
☐ These have to have a pull-top lid; there will be no openers available.
☐ Disposable spoon
☐ One small, soft pack of tissues
☐ 2 hard candy pieces
☐ One poncho, small, purse-size (available at Target, etc.)

Please avoid salty snack foods that will increase thirst. If your child has any particular medical needs, please consider ensuring that our office has a 24-48 hour supply of medication available at all times. The kits will be sent home at the end of the school year. Please replenish with fresh supplies and return at the beginning of the next school year. Thank you for working together with us to help keep our kids safe!
