Emergency Supply Kit

3) Supply List:

☐ One small flashlight with batteries
☐ Two small boxed drinks
☐ One can of food with a pull-top lid (protein item ideal)
One can of dessert with pull-top lid: Fruit, salad, pudding, etc. (These have to have a pull-top
lid; there will be no can-openers available.)
□ Disposable spoon
☐ One small, soft pack of tissues
2 pieces of hard candy
☐ One poncho, small, purse-size (available at Target, etc.)

Please avoid salty snack foods that will increase thirst. If your child has any particular medical needs, please consider ensuring that our office has a 24-48 hour supply of medication available at all times. The kits will be sent home at the end of the school year. Please replenish with fresh supplies and return at the beginning of the next school year.
