## Communal items - Please do NOT label these

- □ 2 boxes of Crayola colored pencils (24 count each) (no erasable colored pencils please)
- □ 1 box of EXPO <u>black fine-tip</u> dry erase markers (12 count each)
- $\Box$  4 pink erasers
- $\Box$  2 dry erase pockets 10 x 14 inches
- □ 2 Mead Primary K-2 Journals (lined paper with blank space for a drawing at the top of each page)
- $\Box$  5 sheets white cardstock paper
- $\Box$  3 boxes of Kleenex tissues
- $\Box$  1 roll of paper towels
- □ 4 containers of Clorox or Kroger brand disinfecting wipes
- $\Box$  2 bottles of hand sanitizer (8 oz)

## Personal items - Please LABEL these items with your child's name

- □ 2 boxes of broad-tip Crayola <u>classic color</u> markers (8 or 10 count each)
- □ 1 backpack
- $\Box$  1 pencil pouch or pencil box
- □ 1 small manual pencil sharpener (equipped with plastic lid and box to protect the blades and store the pencil shavings)
- □ 1 blue plastic folder
- □ 1 red plastic folder
- $\Box$  1 water bottle
- □ 1 ThinkWrite or similar headset with microphone (use your headset from Kindergarten)
- $\Box$  1 emergency supply kit (see next page)

## **Emergency Supply Kit**

In order to be prepared for emergencies, we request that you send an Emergency Supply Kit to school for each child.

These supply kits are kept in the classrooms, so storage space is limited.

1) All supplies need to fit in a one-gallon, zip-lock plastic bag. (No additional supplies can be accommodated.)

2) On the front of the bag write your child's name, the date the supplies were assembled and any emergency telephone numbers or plans that you have for your family. PLEASE USE A PERMANENT MARKER.

3) Supply List:

A note from you telling your child that he/she has your permission to stay at school until transportation home has been arranged. This is for your child's reassurance.

- □ One space blanket (available at Fred Meyer, Target, etc.)
- □ One small flashlight with batteries
- Two small boxed drinks
- One can of food with pull-top lid (protein item ideal)
- □ One can of dessert with pull-top lid: Fruit, salad, pudding, etc.

These have to have a pull-top lid; there will be no openers available.

- □ Disposable spoon
- □ One small, soft pack of tissues
- □ 2 hard candy pieces
- □ One poncho, small, purse-sized (available at Target, etc.)

Please avoid salty snack foods that will increase thirst. **If your child has any particular medical needs, please consider ensuring that our office has a 24-48 hour supply of medication available at all times.** The kits will be sent home at the end of the school year. Please replenish with fresh supplies and return at the beginning of the next school year. Thank you for working together with us to help keep our kids safe!
