PLEASE DO NOT LABEL THE FOLLOWING SUPPLIES WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME

- (2) canister of bleach-free surface wipes (No baby wipes)
- (2) bottles of hand sanitizer 8 oz (60% alcohol minimum).
- (2) rolls of paper towels
- (3) boxes of Kleenex
- (4) Elmer's glue sticks
- (1) large erasers
- (1) 24 pack colored pencils (Crayola Brand)
- (1) 12 pack markers (Crayola Brand)
- (1) pack of Cardstock Paper (Last name A-M = White / Last name N-Z= Colored).

PLEASE LABEL THE FOLLOWING SUPPLIES WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME

- (4) plastic folders with two pockets: 1 yellow, 1 blue, 1 green, 1 red All folders need to be free of any graphics, pictures or writing (brand names, such as Avery are ok).
- (2) plastic pencil boxes
- (2) sturdy pencil sharpeners with canister
- (1) headset with microphone (Jack compatible) to be reused each year while at Le Monde. See link (for pdf)

PLEASE LABEL YOUR CHILD'S BELONGINGS

IN ADDITION TO THE SUPPLIES ABOVE each student should have the following:

- (1) backpack (big enough to bring back work and folders).
- Rain boots (to keep in the classroom)
- (1) raincoat (to keep in their cubby)
- (1) leak-proof metal or plastic water bottle with a straw/nozzle
- (1) change of clothes respecting Le Monde uniform policy + 1 mask, everything in a bag labeled with their name.
- (1) emergency supply kit (see next page)

In general, all belongings should be <u>labeled with your child's name</u> as they tend to forget or misplace them a lot (especially sweaters and jackets).

Emergency Supply Kit

In order to be prepared for emergencies, we request that you send an Emergency Supply Kit to school for each child.

These supply kits are kept in the classrooms, so storage space is limited.

- 1) All supplies need to fit in a one-gallon, zip-lock plastic bag. (No additional supplies can be accommodated.)
- 2) On the front of the bag write your child's name, the date the supplies were assembled and any emergency telephone numbers or plans that you have for your family. PLEASE USE A PERMANENT MARKER.
