

**Le Monde French Immersion Public Charter School
Grades 6, 7, 8 Supply List for 2024/2025**

These items do not need to be labeled :

- 2 boxes of yellow Ticonderoga #2 pencils, **pre-sharpened** (30 count)
- 1 box of non-retractable red pens (10 count)
- 2 boxes of non-retractable black pens (10 count)
- 2 boxes of black fine or ultra-fine (preferred) EXPO dry-erase **black** markers
- 3-pack Elmer's glue sticks
- 2 erasers
- 2 highlighters
- 2 containers of disinfecting wipes
- 2 tissue boxes
- 2 hand sanitizers (at least 60% alcohol)
- 2 [200-pack of wooden craft sticks](#)
- 1 headset with microphone (Jack compatible) *to be reused each year while at Le Monde.* [See link.](#)

These items need to be labeled with your child's name :

- 1 pencil sharpener with shavings container
- 1 **TI-30Xa** calculator
- 4 plastic 2-pocket folders - 1 red, 1 blue, 1 green, 1 yellow
OR instead of all of the above folders, get one multi-subject binder with dividers and internal folders
- 5 wide-ruled **composition** notebooks (6th)
- 4 wide-ruled composition notebooks (7th + 8th)
- 1 70-sheet wide ruled **spiral** notebook (10.5in x 8in)
- 2 spiral **graph paper** notebooks (8.5 x 11, 100 pages)
(note: students will go through more than one notebook, but the second one does not have to be purchased ahead)
- 2 box of Crayola colored pencils (24 count)
- 1 box of markers (10 count)
- 1 zippered pencil case (6 x 8 inches approximately)
- 2 clean socks (for dry-erase mats)
- 1 pair of student scissors
- 1 non-flexible wooden ruler (with both centimeters and inches)
- 1 Geometry set with compass (or 1 compass, 1 square, and 1 protractor)
- 2 dry-erase pockets (<http://tiny.cc/Osxtjy>) or (C-line dry reusable pocket)
- 1 Larousse pocket-size French/English dictionary
- 1 backpack
- 1 leak-proof metal or plastic water bottle with a straw/nozzle
- 1 emergency kit (see next page)

Emergency Supply Kit

In order to be prepared for emergencies, we request that you send an Emergency Supply Kit to school for each child. These supply kits are kept in the classrooms, so storage space is limited.

1) All supplies need to fit in a one-gallon, zip-lock plastic bag. (No additional supplies can be accommodated.)

2) On the front of the bag write your child's name, the date the supplies were assembled and any emergency telephone numbers or plans that you have for your family.

PLEASE USE A PERMANENT MARKER.

3) Supply List:

A note from you telling your child that he/she has your permission to stay at school until transportation home has been arranged. This is for your child's reassurance.

One space blanket (available at Fred Meyer, Target, etc.)

One small flashlight with batteries

Two small boxed drinks

One can of food with pull-top lid (protein item ideal)

One can of dessert with pull-top lid: Fruit, salad, pudding, etc.

These have to have a pull-top lid; there will be no openers available.

Disposable spoon

One small, soft pack of tissues

2 hard candy pieces

One poncho, small, purse-size (available at Target, etc.)

Please avoid salty snack foods that will increase thirst. If your child has any particular medical needs, please consider ensuring that our office has a 24-48 hour supply of medication available at all times. The kits will be sent home at the end of the school year. Please replenish with fresh supplies and return at the beginning of the next school year.
