Grade 3 Supply List for 2025 - 2026

These items must NOT be labeled:

- 18 or more **thin-tipped BLACK** Expo dry erase markers
- 1 box of yellow Tricondera #2 pencils, **pre-sharpened** (30 count)
- 2 pairs of **white** cotton socks to erase dry-erase pockets
- [1 package of 5 C-line dry reusable pocket](#)
- 6 **pink** erasers
- At least 6 Elmer's glue sticks
- 2 felt-tipped pens: one **red** and one **black**
- 3 tissue boxes
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer **with at least 60% alcohol**
- 1 container Lysol-type disinfecting wipes
- 1 ream of white printer paper
- Optional: 1 pack of white cardstock paper
- Optional: 1 pack of quart-sized Ziplocs and 1 pack of gallon-sized Ziplocs

The items below should be labeled with your child's first name and last initial:

- 2 wide-ruled composition notebooks: one **black** cover and one **colored** cover
- 3 plastic two pocket folders: one **red**, one **blue**, and one **green**
- 1 hardcover 3 ring binder **1.0"** with see-through sleeve on cover and back
- 1 set of 5 divider tabs
- 1 pair of child scissors
- 1 **large** pencil pouch **with multiple pockets OR** 2 normal size pencil pouches
- 1 box of Crayola colored pencils (24 count) - **pre-sharpened**
- 1 **wooden** or **metal** ruler - 30 cm / 12 in (**with centimeters and inches indicated**)
- [1 Merriam-Webster's pocket size French/English dictionary \(this brand and size\)](#)
- 1 headset with microphone (can reuse last school year's), see [link](#)
- 1 backpack
- 1 leak-proof water bottle
- 1 emergency supply kit (see next page)

Emergency Supply Kit

In order to be prepared for emergencies, we request that you send an Emergency Supply Kit to school for each child.

These supply kits are kept in the classrooms, so storage space is limited.

- 1) All supplies need to fit in a one-gallon, zip-lock plastic bag. (No additional supplies can be accommodated.)
- 2) On the front of the bag write your child's name, the date the supplies were assembled and any emergency telephone numbers or plans that you have for your family. PLEASE USE A PERMANENT MARKER.

3) Supply List:

- A note from you telling your child that he/she has your permission to stay at school until transportation home has been arranged. This is for your child's reassurance.
- One space blanket (available at Fred Meyer, Target, etc.)
- One small flashlight with batteries
- Two small boxed drinks
- One can of food with pull-top lid. (Protein item ideal.)
- One can of dessert with pull-top lid. (Fruit salad, pudding, etc.)
- Disposable spoon
- One small, soft pack of tissues
- 2 hard candy pieces
- One poncho, small, purse-size (available at Target, etc.)

Please avoid salty snack foods that will increase thirst. Make sure any cans have pull top lids, as can openers will not be available. **If your child has any particular medical needs, please consider ensuring that our office has a 24-48 hour supply of medication available at all times.** The kits will be sent home at the end of the school year. Please replenish with fresh supplies and return at the beginning of the next school year. Thank you for working together with us to help keep our kids safe!
